This includes disassembling the forklift, rebuilding the engine, sandblasting the lift and then reassembling the whole thing and finishing with a fresh coat of paint.

To correctly and thoroughly reconstruct a lift truck engine, a good business would completely disassemble it. A heat cleaning system could then be utilized to clean all the components. As soon as this step has been finished, all of the components are checked to see if they have any extensive wear, any defects or breakage. Specific parts like for instance crankshafts, cylinder blocks, connecting rods and cylinder heads are reground, resurfaced and resized if needed. Several parts like for example gears, nuts, bolts et cetera. are repaired or replaced as needed.

The engine is rebuilt by hand once the overhaul has been finished. After putting it back together, a series of tests are applied to the working equipment. This is done in order to check all of the components to ensure there are no issues or leaks. If any problems occur, the necessary adjustments are made.
