Compared to the quick-tach container models, universal fit buckets are 50% deeper. This additional room makes them ideal for carrying irregular shaped loads like backfilling behind walls, tearing off roof trash, elevating roof gravel, moving large debris piles and broken up concrete.

Moreover, constructed as additions intended for extendable-reach forklifts, Quick-Tack buckets, are designed to tolerate the placement of materials way beyond the standard reach of the loader. A hardened beveled cutting blade on both sides and on the leading edge reinforces stability, resistance to damage and provides supreme durability.
